Application Process:

For Grades 1 – 8

All students entering First Grade must be six by October 1st.

Applications for the current school year can be hand delivered, mailed or emailed to:

ihmoffice@ihmschoolbelmont.org . A screening test will be administered as part of the admissions process.

Upon receipt of the completed application, and the items requested above, we will establish a file for your child. We will then contact you confirming a date and time for the screening.

Letters of acceptance will be mailed. If your child is accepted to the school following the evaluation and the grade is full, your child will be placed on our waiting list. We will contact you when an opening occurs.
